RED WINES

Beronia Tempranillo Rioja 2006 (Spain)

Mouthwatering acidity and subtle American oak barrel spice; Intense, juicy, plump, black cherry fruit and explosion of flavor in the mid palate.

Bodegas Borsao Tres Picos Garnacha 2007 (Spain)

Rich aroma of ripe berries with hints of floral tones typical of the Garnacha; Full bodied rich wine with a taste of blackberries, strawberries and hints of vanilla and plums.

Nero d’Avola 2007 (Italy)

Gorgeous, full bodied Nero d’Avola bursting with sweet dark cherries, menthol, sage and flowers; Offers notable clarity and elegance.

Tenuta Rapitala Nuar Nero D’Avola 2005 (Italy)

Delightful, brambly mix of raspberry, cherry, green olive and tea.

Puech Auriol Ad Hoc Coteaux D’enserune 2007 (France)

Blend of Grenache with aromas of ripe cassis, blueberry, toasted nuts; Leads to an equally diverse set of flavors and a saline, subtly bitter, black-fruited finish.

Quinta do Crasto 2006 (Portugal)

Fruity and juicy, with plenty of cherry, red plum and berry flavors; Creamy element that runs through to the finish.

WHITE WINES

Pazo de Senorans Albarino Rias Brixas 2006 (Spain)

Fragrant aromatic array of spring flowers, peach, citrus and lemon meringue; Crisp, focused and intensely flavored.

Aires Pecorino Colline Pescasesi 2007 (Italy)

Fascinating golden yellow color, soft and structured with elegant notes of flowers, hazelnut and peach.

Lurton Le Salices Viognier (France)

Peachy aromas and flavors fill this medium-bodied White; Smoky notes on the finish.

Bzikot Bourgogne Blanc 2007 (France)

100% Chardonnay showing great minerality and fresh butter aromas along with a hint of pear and hazelnut scents.

Loius Jadot Puligny Montrachet 2005 (France)

Elegant, medium bodied Chardonnay is characterized by peachy stone fruit and melon flavors and aromas set in a firm, balanced structure ending in a fresh, racy finish.

Justino’s Rainwater Madeira (Portugal)

Translucent, with a shiny golden color; Pleasant aroma, and a sensation of freshness and long dry finish; Notes of cocoa, grape, apple and walnut.
